# II. Technical/Load-in Information

# Stage Specs

- Stage: 110' wide x 65' deep (7,270 sq. ft)
- Proscenium: 30' high x 53'4" wide
- Fly System: 87-line sets, counterweight system
- Upstage bustle: 53' wide x 38' deep x 26'4" high
- (2) 8' x 8' traps
- Stage Left wing: 1000 square feet concrete
- Stage Right wing: 2400 square feet concrete
- Floor: Tongue and groove maple with a dark stain on sleepers. May not be painted. Limited screwing and lagging allowed with approval.
- Orchestra Pit: 1,650 sq. ft. | Accommodates 95 musicians
  - 53' wide and 32' deep including the under-stage space. 16' of pit is under stage and not height adjustable. Lift comprises the downstage 16' of the pit and is split into upstage and downstage lifts. Each lift may be stopped at any height in its travel. Maximum pit depth is 9'-6" below stage level.

#### House Curtain

Burgundy velour with fringe. Guillotine only. Center split for paging. Counterweight hand set operates from stage left, stage level.

#### Video Equipment

The Opera House has video equipment in-house to accomplish a number of specific tasks. A balcony rail mounted camera feeds the stage manager's console and several backstage and lobby monitors with a show program feed. If needed, a camera mounted in the pit is focused on the conductor and the feed sent to monitors on the balcony rail, the stage manager's console and roving monitors on stage.

#### Loading Dock

- Two 53' trailer capacity
- Ramp access to stage level

Dock is fenced on all sides with access gates for truck entry and auxiliary loading access. Two dock levelers will accommodate trucks higher or lower than standard dock height. An aluminum walk ramp (capacity 1000lbs) is available for drop frame trailers. The house does not provide forklifts. Total square footage for the dock is approximately 500 square feet. All material must travel down an incline into the theatre. This ramp drops 3' over 22' of travel. Two Johnson bars and various dollies are available to assist loading.

# Rigging and Fly System

- Counterweight System: 87-line sets (63' long) plus (1) stage left and right tab set. Line travel 82'
- Arbor capacity 1900 lbs. including batten weight.
- (12) sch. 40 truss battens. 63' long
- (75) sch. 80 single pipe battens. 63' long
- (2) lock rails SL. One at deck and one at pin rail (+40' 5")
- Six lift lines per set. Lines 5'9", 17'3" and 28'9" left and right of center.
- Additional hang points are located down stage of plaster line.

# Hemp Rigging

- Pin rails SL and SR at +40'5" from deck.
- (72) 8" grid mounted loft block. Sized for 3/4" rope.
- (10) four line, 8" hemp head blocks. Sized for 3/4" rope.
- (32) single line hemp head blocks. Sized for 3/4" rope.
- (32) 8" Rope spot blocks Matching well sheaves

#### Gridiron

- 85 feet above stage level. Grid surface is structural steel grating.
- Roof mounted loft blocks
- 5'8" x 5'8" access doors through grating with a beam overhead for hoisting.
- Stair access to sixth floor. Mandatory 20ft, ladder climb to working grid level

#### Wardrobe

- 725 square feet wardrobe room at basement level with freight elevator access.
- 3 Washers, 3 Dryers.
- Rolling wardrobe racks available upon request.

# Dressing Rooms

- Basement
  - Conductor's dressing room 185 square feet with private washroom
  - (3) Chorus dressing rooms 500 square feet each. Suitable for up to 12 performers each.
  - o Musician's Lounge 750 square feet washrooms are down the hall and are shared with the Chorus dressing rooms.
- Stage Level

 (3) Principal/Star dressing rooms with a washroom and shower in each. Suitable for 1-2 performers.

#### Second Level

- Room 211 175 square feet with washroom attached. Suitable for 3-5 performers.
- o Room 213 120 square feet with washroom attached. Suitable for 3-5 performers.
- Room 214 145 square feet with washroom attached. Suitable for 3-5 performers.

#### Third Level

 Unisex Chorus room with full men's and women's washrooms attached. Suitable for 35-40. performers.

# Storage Space

Storage of empty boxes and unused equipment can be accommodated. On larger shows it may be necessary to load empties back to the truck. Consult with the technical director to discuss individual needs.

### **Union Labor**

- IATSE Local #38 (Stagehands), Local #786 (Wardrobe)
  - The Detroit Opera House operates under agreements with the International Alliance of Theatrical Stage Employees (IATSE), locals #38 and #786. All stage work connected with a production will be covered under the terms of that agreement. Stagehands will be used for all work on temporary platforms installed in the auditorium of the theatre as well as the stage. Lobby areas will utilize stagehand labor for all installation of theatrical, electrical, or audiovisual equipment. Clients should contact the technical director with complete production requirements to facilitate a labor estimate well in advance of each event.

# Truck Parking

The loading dock accommodates (2) 53-foot trailers and attached tractors for short periods of time. When parking trucks on the street, it is recommended that drivers remain with the tractors. Long-term trailer accommodation can be made upon request.

#### Road Production Offices

The road production offices are located upstage left, across the hall from the star dressing rooms. They are suitable for up to three people per room. Long distance is accessed via credit card only. Both offices offer wired Internet access. Ethernet cables are NOT supplied. Office 1 has four phone lines, Office 2 has two phone lines.

#### Musicians

The Detroit Opera House operates under an agreement with the Detroit Federation of Musicians, local 5, AF of M. All auditorium events requiring local musicians must engage them and the terms of this agreement. Please contact the Technical Director for more information.
